
Spa Products Care and Cleaning Recommendations

KOHLER BubbleMassage™ Baths Commercial Care and Cleaning

AFTER EACH CLIENT:

- Drain water from the bath and remove any debris.
- Wash all the surfaces of the bath with soap or detergent and rinse.
- Spray thoroughly with an EPA-registered disinfectant containing bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal ingredients, following the specific manufacturer's instructions.
- Dry the bath with a clean, soft towel.

AT THE END OF EACH DAY:

- Fill bath with water one inch above the top of all airjets.
- While bath is filling, carefully add 1 cup of bleach to the water.
- Let sit for 10–15 minutes.
- Drain the water, run the purge cycle and rinse any debris from the bath.
- Clean thoroughly with an EPA-registered disinfectant with bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal ingredients, following the specific manufacturer's instructions.
- Dry the bath with a clean, soft towel.

MAINTAINING THE AIRJETS:

- If cleaning the airjets is required due to hard water deposits, use a small between-the-teeth dental brush and white vinegar. Dip the brush in the vinegar, brush the hole, rinse the brush in clean water, then use the rinsed brush to clean the hole.
- Fill the bath with water to the top row of airjets. Drain bath and run the purge cycle.

KOHLER Whirlpools Commercial Care and Cleaning

AFTER EACH CLIENT:

- Drain water from the whirlpool and remove any debris.
- Wash all the surfaces of the whirlpool with soap or detergent and rinse.
- Spray thoroughly with an EPA-registered disinfectant containing bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal ingredients, following the specific manufacturer's instructions.
- Dry the whirlpool with a clean, soft towel.

AT THE END OF EACH DAY:

- From the whirlpool, remove the intake suction screen and remove any debris.
- Wash the screen thoroughly with soap or detergent.
- Before reinstalling the screen, immerse it in an EPA-registered disinfectant containing bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal ingredients.
- Reinstall the intake suction screen.
- Fill whirlpool with warm water at least two inches above the highest jet.
- Carefully pour 2 cups of bleach and 1 cup of low-foaming powder automatic dishwasher detergent into the water.
- Turn on the whirlpool and allow the solution to circulate for 5–10 minutes.
- Drain the whirlpool.
- Fill the whirlpool with clean water and run the whirlpool for a few minutes to flush the system.
- Drain the whirlpool and rinse with clean water.
- Clean thoroughly with an EPA-registered disinfectant with bactericidal, fungicidal and virucidal ingredients, following the specific manufacturer's instructions.
- Dry the bath with a clean, soft towel.
